### RoSPA Award

We are pleased to announce Instalcom have been awarded the RoSPA Gold Medal for the seventh consecutive year for demonstrating high health and safety standards through collective efforts from our SHEO department, Project Delivery Teams and dedicated support functions, and collaboration with Supply Chain partners and our valued clients across the construction and utilities sector. Organisations receiving a RoSPA Award are recognised as being world-leaders in health and safety practice. Every year, there are nearly 2,000 entrants to achieve the highest possible accolade in what is the UK's longest-running H&S industry awards.



A Virtual Awards Ceremony will be held in September to celebrate the success. The Awards Ceremony will be hosted by Broadcaster and Journalist Ed James, RoSPA President Baroness Jolly, and RoSPA chief executive, Errol Taylor. During the ceremony, RoSPA will be running an online auction and collection donations during the ceremony to raise funds for their vital Keeping Kids Safe Campaign to "Change our society for the better, so that no young child is needlessly hurt or killed in an accident that didn't have to happen."

### **HS2 Diversion Works**

As part of the HS2 Utilities diversion works in Denham, Instalcom were appointed to by Align JV to divert an 800mm water main diversion to allow for construction of the 3.37km Viaduct in this area. With the 800mm install in this area we had to overcome an extremely high-water table & flow we had to install a lot of dewatering to allow us to carry out our works, we had to follow extremely high parameters from the EA & Align environmental team to allow us to discharge set quantities of water daily. Instalcom had a lot of involvement with the asset owner Affinity Water and Align in approval of the works and completed on time. Due the high running pressures of this Trunk Main large very large thrust block were required at either end of the tie in points to the original main.

### Innovative Formwork Solution

Engineering Enterprise Finan Formworks, leaders of plastic formwork solutions and plastic plywood across the construction industry continually share and integrate innovative solutions that are practical & hugely beneficial for any particular project requirements which we have implemented across our power projects. Plus Form is innovative vertical plastic formwork used for the construction of concrete walls, pillars, walls, plinths, and foundations directly on site which can be pre-assembled on the ground, removed and handled without exceeding manual operation weight limits. An innovative low carbon solution to traditional framework made from ABS (Acrylonitrile Butadiene Styrene) a form of polymer, known for its impact resistance and toughness resulting in stability underload.

We are the first to utilise the innovative formwork on behalf of WPD (Western Power Distribution) as part the installation of a new 66kV infeed to Bloxham 66/11kV PSS which requires installation of new 66kV circuit breakers and associated switches, within the existing compound and installation of additional protection panels within the existing switch room.



# **Eltham Passive Optical Network**



Eltham W1A delivery is officially up and running. To mark the first PON (passive optical network) being tested Openreach and Instalcom attended site as the first set of results came in, this is another significant step in delivering ultra-fast and ultra-reliable broadband services across the Falcon program in the south. During field trials of PON technology, it was identified companies can develop an even wider range of services and speeds for the UK's allowing providers to offer consumers and business in the future, allowing them to upgrade customers quickly, smoothly and with no disruption.





# **Macmillan Coffee Morning**

## **Lumen Contract Award**

Instalcom has been awarded a rail contract by Lumen previously known as Century Link to install, joint terminate and test 35 kilometres of 48 fibre cables within the Network Rail corridor. The scope will include survey, route clearance, civils and cable installation. Works will be undertaken using the existing 'Deed of Grant' agreement between Network Rail and Lumen. The installation works are in the Wiltshire area and form 2 x discreet sections (Bradford to Westbury and Townsend to Westbury). Currently in the pre-construction phase, it is expected physical works will commence in October 2021 (subject to Network Rail access planning timescales).

### Network Rail Telecom Contract Award

Instalcom continue to be the preferred supplier for the installation of Fibre Interface Points (FIPs) on behalf of Network Rail. The latest requirement is to install a FIP at the NR Neville Hill Depot. Scope of works includes civils, cable installation, termination and testing. The new FIP will utilise the NR backbone fibre installed by FTN to provide FTNx and IP networks in support of the new Digital Railway, whilst further enhancing rail safety, cost and performance.

### **Positive Feedback**

It is also highly important to follow measures including wearing correct PPE, ensuring you are fully competent and aware of the risks of the works you are carrying out, reading and displaying signage throughout sites, using technology such as our lone working apps, inspect tools and equipment regularly, carrying out and continually reviewing risk assessments and communicating any reportable incidents or near-misses to ensure the safety of personnel, visors etc.
